


NEPAL SAFE HOUSES OFFERING HOPE & LOVE

We are so excited to have a board and supporters like you

who take joy in giving and in helping those in the most dire need. The absolute epidemic of human trafficking around the world has grown at alarming rates over recent years. The *International Labor Organization* and *Walk Free*

Foundation have estimated that some 40.3 million people are enslaved worldwide. Numbers like these are very difficult to comprehend. Thinking about just one child living life as an owned object, enslaved and devalued, is unacceptable. The world as a whole, and each of us individually is in dire need of salvation. Praise God for his power, and for the power of his people working together to save orphans from this terrible fate. We are so pleased to be working closely with Save Asian Souls to rescue the children most in danger of falling prey to human traffickers.
